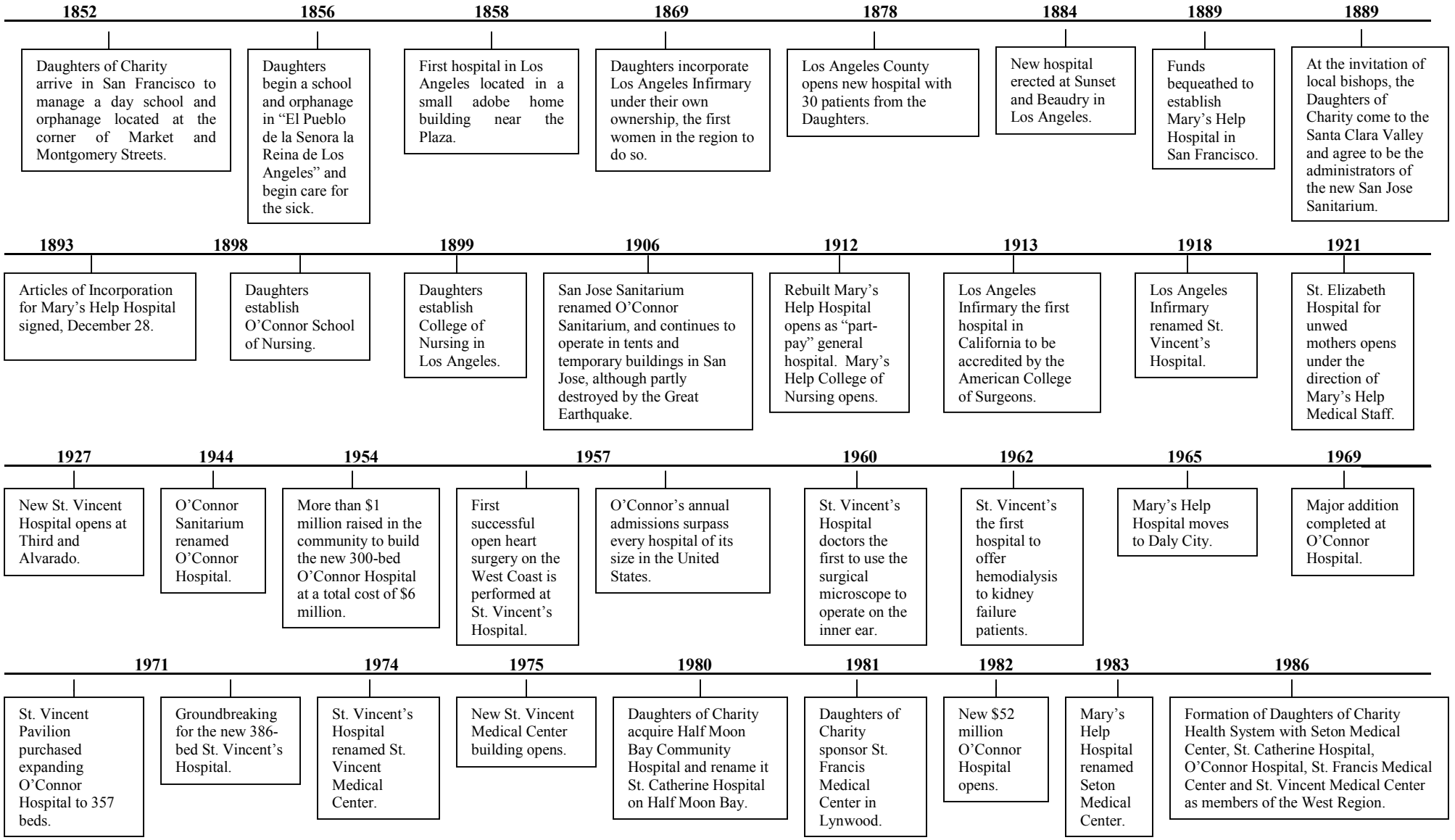

2000

Saint Louise Health Center moves to Gilroy; renamed Saint Louise Regional Hospital.

2001

Creation of Daughters of Charity Health System including St. Vincent Medical Center, Seton Medical Center, Seton Medical Center Coastside, O'Connor Hospital, St. Francis Hospital, Saint Louise Regional Hospital and Robert F. Kennedy Medical Center.
